



ANNUAL WELLNESS DIAGNOSTIC TESTING

Our hospital strives to offer the highest quality of care for your pet. As part of your pet's annual physical examination and immunizations, we also will be performing a blood and urine screening. The purpose of the screening is to help us find hidden problems that would not be detected during a physical examination. We believe the best medicine is to prevent problems when possible. When that is not possible (as is generally the case with age-related diseases) then recognizing and instituting treatment before symptoms begin can be the best approach. We feel this program will help with prevention, early detection, and timely intervention, which can significantly impact the longevity and quality of life for your growing pet. The chart below will help you determine your pet's age in human years. Then you can determine his/her wellness classification as Adult or Senior.
